

What are some reasons for the inequalities of clinical trials?

Misinformation

- Translation to different languages often creates miscommunication Lack of information
- Translators are not always available
- Information is being delivered at a 12th grade reading level

Trust barriers

Reaching out to groups in a culturally competent way

- Language that researchers use can come across as offensive when they use words like subjects, experimentive **Location of clinical trials**
- Travel expenses
- Clinical research sites should be in locations accessible to diverse populations





What are some ways we can change the disparities?

Misinformation

• Instead of translating information we need to transcreate Lack of information

- Make translators and interpreters available
- Information should be given at a 5th grade reading level

Trust barriers

- You have to develop a relationship
- Change the language being used
- Following up with patients to ensure that they understand
- Reaching out to groups in a culturally competent way
- Prioritize from the beginning the need to be culturally competent and build it into the process, and not add it on after the trial has started

Location of clinical trials

• Gather resources for travel compensation, Uber, Lyft, etc.





What is the connection between the lack of diverse representation in clinical trials and racial and ethnic disparities?


- Social disparities

Social and Economic Factors Drive Health Outcomes




